This hand is probably that of Professor Bithell, who was the recipient of the corrected pages, as can be seen by a dedication similar to that in (i) above, on the reverse of the page. All the pages are in poor condition. (iii) 2 bifolia of thin, typewritten paper containing a poem by Ernst Bertram, "Die Fenster von Chartres", which is also dedicated to Prof. Bithell. Bertram's inscription at the end of the poem reads "Köln/1939-40. Erschienen während des Krieges im "Inneren Reich", München. Für M. Jethro Bithell in Penzance/Cornwall dankbar erwidernd. Januar 1949 Ernst Bertram" ('Cologne, 1939-40. Published during the War in the "Inner Reich", Munich'). (i) Press cuttings, notes and clippings mainly on German/English vocabulary, and a translation of two poems by Mörike; (ii) book review written by hand on Paula Grogger's <i>Das Grimmingtor</i> (Breslau, 1926, rev. 1932); (iii) a folder of handwritten notes and a typewritten book review by JBI, together with an extremely fragile set of typewritten poems by Ernst Bertram, presented to JBI as before; cannot be handled	Undated; press clippings, from content, probably post-WWII; 1949
