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## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Fuller Collection of documents and seals was presented to the University of London Library in 1965 by Mrs. E. Fuller, through the National Art Collections Fund. The collection was made by Mrs. Fuller's late husband Captain A.W.F. Fuller and by his father, the Reverend Alfred Fuller.

This list gives a brief description of over a thousand documents with dates ranging from the twelfth to the nineteenth century, which are contained in thirty-three boxes and represent approximately half of the total documentary content of the collection.

The interest of the collectors lay primarily in the seals and only secondarily in the documents. In many instances the seals have been removed from their documents. No description of the seals is given here as a separate and detailed seal catalogue is in process of being compiled.

As time was limited, this list is restricted to supplying three items of information about each document - date, geographical location and type. In addition, however, the contents of a document have been described if the document is either a very early one (i.e. before A.D. 1300) or does not constitute a common and readily classifiable type.

The documents are mainly British, mainly in the Latin language and mainly title deeds. Since they have lost their original archival contexts they have been grouped geographically for the purpose of this list. The main grouping is by pre-1974 counties. Within each county entries are filed alphabetically by town or village containing the property which was the subject-matter of the transaction that caused the drawing up of the document. In the case of bonds, entries are filed under the place of residence of both debtor and creditor. The first-mentioned place determines the alphabetical filing of a document and all other places mentioned in the document are also shown. If any of these places are in other counties duplicate entries appear under the appropriate county heading. When there are several documents from the same place, they are listed in chronological order.

After the County Lists there are three indexes - a Place Index, a Classified Index of types of documents, and a Date Index. These provide the reference numbers of all relevant documents.

The key to the location of entries in the County Lists is provided by the Box List at the end of the volume. For example, if the reference is 32/4 look in the Box List under Box 32, item 4, and the place-name and county under which that document is entered in the lists will be found, typed in capital letters.

Fifty-six counties in Great Britain and Ireland are represented in this list. The three most represented counties are Suffolk with 196 documents, Kent with 186 documents and Norfolk with 176. Other counties that are represented by 30 or more documents are Yorkshire, Shropshire, London, Devon, Derby and Sussex.

There are some important localised clusters of documents.

## INTRODUCTION

In Kent there are over 70 documents from Hawkhurst, mostly belonging to the sixteenth, seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, and another cluster from the Greenhithe-Northfleet-Gravesend area.

The Suffolk documents date mainly from the fourteenth and fifteenth centuries. In central Suffolk there are over 100 documents from Gipping, Old Newton, the Creetinges and other nearby towns and villages and in northeast Suffolk there is a group from Spexhall and other villages in the Halesworth area.

In Norfolk there are over 50 documents from Edgefield and another group from Beetley, Bittering and nearby villages.

In Shropshire an important group of early documents comes from the area around Bishop's Castle and includes many thirteenth and fourteenth century documents.

The East Riding of Yorkshire provides some of the most interesting documents in the collection. This group relates to land which belonged to Bridlington Priory and many of the documents concern their manor of Little Kelk from the thirteenth to the sixteenth century.

Taken altogether there is a splendid variety of documents in this part of the Fuller Collection and I have included in this volume a Classified Index of types, which I hope may prove to be of some use to students of diplomatic.

The bulk of the documents, approximately eighty per cent, is composed of title deeds and related documents. The outstanding feature is a magnificent collection of private gifts, or charters. There are over 400 of them ranging in date from the twelfth to the seventeenth century and they vary interestingly in style and type. Alongside the gifts is a good collection of over 70 quitclaims. Leases, bargains and sales, lease-and-releases, final concords, exemplifications, settlements, bonds and receipts are all well represented, and there is an interesting collection of over 60 copies of court roll of various types, for the detailed study of which the manuscript manor court formulary booklet, Box 4/43 would prove useful. In addition, amongst the small but important group of documents pertaining to the manor there are several compoti and court rolls, many of them relating to Kelk, Yorks., E.R.

I have included a Date Index in this volume which I hope will be a useful aid to students of British palaeography and to those interested in taking a chronological view of the diplomatic of British title deeds.

## 2. EDITOR'S NOTES

### Dates

Regnal year dates and saints' days and festivals have been converted into modern dates using the tables in C.R. Cheney, Handbook of Dates (1945). Anno Domini dates are as written in the documents except for those pre-1752 dates lying between 1 January and 24 March which have been given in modern form, for example 2 Jan. 1602 not 2 Jan. 1601/2. Estimated dates are enclosed in square brackets and are based either on evidence contained in the subject-matter of the document or on palaeographical considerations.

### Places

Place-names and counties are given in the form in which they are printed in J. Bartholomew, Survey Gazetteer of the British Isles (ninth edition, reprinted 1963). Unidentified names have been transcribed and are shown enclosed in round brackets. An inconclusive identification is shown enclosed in square brackets with a question mark and appears underneath the transcribed form of the word.

The places given refer normally to the location of the property that is being conveyed but in the case of bonds they are the places of residence of the parties. In the case of manorial documents they refer to the location of the manors, and in the case of wills and administrations, to the place of residence of the deceased.

### Language

The majority of the documents is written in Latin and most of the remainder in English. The language in which a document is written has not normally been recorded. However, when a document which would normally be expected to be in Latin is in English, this fact is recorded; similarly with documents which would normally be in English which are in fact in Latin. The use of all other languages has been recorded in every instance.

### Physical condition

The condition of the documents has not been described except in cases where damage or a missing part has made some of the document illegible.

### Classification of types

In compiling a concise list such as this, one is faced with the difficulty of classifying a large number of documents of various types while using only a few words of description. The difficulty is increased in the case of conveyancing deeds by the long and complex nature of many of the documents and

by the long time span involved, stretching from the twelfth century to the nineteenth century.

Two principles underlie this list. The first is the importance of making clear the nature of the estate or interest being conveyed. The second is the importance of making clear whether this estate or interest was in corporeal or incorporeal property. In accordance with the first principle, the distinction between a conveyance of a freehold estate and a leasehold estate is considered to override considerations of outward form. For example, four indentures of bargain and sale would find themselves described as four different types in this list if one were conveying a freehold estate in perpetuity, a second were conveying a leasehold estate for a term of years, a third were a lease for a year which was part of a lease-and-release and therefore a conveyance of a freehold estate, and a fourth were a mortgage transaction. These would be described in this list as 1) Bargain and sale (conveyance), 2) Lease for years, 3) Lease for 1 year, part of a lease-and-release, and 4) Mortgage.

In accordance with the second principle, gifts and grants have been distinguished from each other although their form and phrasing are usually very similar. Documents have been described as gifts if they recorded conveyance of freehold estate in corporeal hereditaments, required livery of seisin and used a formula of words based upon the phrase '*dedi concessi et hac presenti carta mea confirmavi*'. However, the variations on this formula are many. Many of the gifts do not use the verb '*dare*' but employ others such as '*feoffare*', '*assignare*', '*liberare*', '*tradere*', '*dimittere*', etc. The verb '*dimittere*' occurs frequently in different types of documents in this collection from gifts to leases for life to leases for years and I have not considered it helpful to classify these various documents as '*Demises*'.

Documents conveying incorporeal property have been described as grants. What has been granted is briefly described. A grant can be assumed to be in perpetuity unless a term has been noted, as in '*Grant of manorial stewardship, for life*'.

Documents have been described as Quitclaims which state that one party, not seised, releases a claim in property to another party and use the formula '*Remisi relaxavi et... quietumclamavi*'. If the verb '*concedere*' is included in the formula, as in '*Concessi remisi relaxavi*' etc., the document has been described as Concession and Quitclaim. If the party who was releasing the claim was seised of the property, the document has been described as a Surrender.

Gifts, grants and quitclaims can be assumed to be deeds poll unless described as indented.

Some fifteenth and sixteenth century gifts in this collection use the verbs '*barganizare*' and '*vendere*'. One splendid example from the sixteenth century (Box 28/17) uses the phrase '*barganizasse vendidisse dedisse concessisse*'

liberasse feoffasse et hac presenti scripto meo confirmasse'. The term Bargain and Sale (conveyance) has been restricted to post-1535 documents in the form of an indenture of bargain and sale ('hath granted aliened bargained and sold') conveying a freehold estate in perpetuity and not requiring livery of seisin.

A type of document which appears to be a curious hybrid between a bargain and sale and a gift takes a similar form to an indenture of bargain and sale but uses the phrase 'hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed' and instead of being enrolled is endorsed with livery of seisin. Logically it is a gift, but it is so different in form from the medieval type as to warrant being placed in a class of its own. In this list this type is described as Bargain and Sale with Feoffment.

Finally, all documents recording the conveyance of an estate in real property for a finite period, determinate or indeterminate in years, have been described as leases. Leases for a year which were part of a lease-and-release and a way of conveying real property in perpetuity, have been distinguished from real leases by the phrase 'part of a lease-and-release'.
