CONTEXT

Biographical/Administrative History: No information was available at the time of compilation.

CONTENT

Scope and Content: Research materials for the fourth programme of a Granada Television Ltd series on the history of Apartheid, covering events during the period 1978-1986. Includes research documents and preparatory material, audio tapes and transcripts of research interviews and filmed interviews, and press cuttings. There is also a series of audio tapes and transcripts of research and filmed interviews for the first programme in the series, covering the origins of Apartheid; and a video tape of the completed version of the first three programmes.

ACCESS AND USE

Language of Scripts: English

System of Arrangement: The material has been arranged according to record type: those for the fourth programme have been dealt with first, followed by the tapes and transcripts for the first programme, and finally a small section of materials relating to the completed programmes. The original order of documents, tapes and transcripts within series has been retained.

Conditions of Access: Open for research. At least 24 hours notice before a research visit. However, access to individual items in archival collections may be restricted under the Data Protection Act or the Freedom of Information Act. Prior arrangement must be made to listen to the audio tapes.

Conditions of Reproduction: A photocopying service is available at the discretion of the Library staff. Copies are supplied solely for research and private study. Requests to publish, or to quote from, original material should be submitted to the Library.
