4. Letter, E. T. Dyson to Bertha, 21.4.11. Includes description of journey from Trincomalee to Batticaloa via Upai(?), Kilivelti, Kathinaveli, Valaichchenai. At Batticalca, account of his first visit to the prison in his capacity as Assistant Inspector of the Prison; account of a case in court where he presided as Police Magistrate. 7 leaves.
