Photographs including Ashanti war, c1891; Chief Oko Jumbo's corpse and people of Bonny, 1891; King of Benin with Mr. Moor, chief officer of Bonny river, 1897; African Association Wharf, Jubilee Day, Bonny, 1897; Chief Abbey Hart and his wives and children, Degema village, 1897; St Stephens Cathedral, Bonny, 1897 June; steamship "Joy", Bonny river, 1898; group of Europeans and chiefs at instllation of Chief Ezekiel Hart, 1905 March; Sir R. Moore and chiefs, slaves conference, Bonny, 1901; Bishop Samuel Ajayi Crowther, c1890; brides returning from church, 1902; opening of Port Harcourt, 1912 April; construction of Port Harcourt, 1913-1914.
