CONTEXT

Biographical/Administrative History: Peter Hjul became active in the Liberal Party and chaired the Cape Provincial Division. He chaired the editorial board of the radical fortnightly "Contact" and was also the editor of the South African Shipping News and Fishing Industry Review. He and his family were harassed by South African security forces. The Hjul family emigrated to the United Kingdom in 1965, where Peter Hjul continued his career as a journalist.
