# Colin Legum papers (ICS 47)

1946-1977

Colin Legum was born in 1919, From the mid-1950s to the mid 1980s he reported on foreign affairs for the Observer, and researched and recorded the current state of Africa in many monographs as well as in the series of volumes which have been published as the "Africa contemporary record" (1968/1969-).

The collection of papers held at the Institute of Commonwealth Studies Library comprises of papers acquired by Colin Legum on Cyprus, Aden, Malta, and Commonwealth matters, 1950-1977, comprising papers on Cyprus, 1955-1966, including copies of official papers, 1957-1959, unofficial publications, statements by George Rossides to the United Nations on the Cyprus Issue, Jan-Feb 1957, unpublished material on Colonel George Grivas, 1957-1958, unpublished material on allegations of brutality by British forces in Cyprus, 1957, Observer Foreign News Service reprints of articles by Arnold Toynbee, Herman Goult, Andrew Wilson, Robert Stephens and Kenneth Mackenzie on Cyprus, Greece and Turkey, 1958-1966, and press notices, 1955-1964.
