MS1175/1	1924 October 25	Communist demonstration at Trafalgar Square - photograph	Demonstration prompted by Zinoviev letter (Central Press photograph)
MS1175/2	c1927	<i>Trade Union Covenant</i>	Trade Union Defence Committee leaflet, pledging to keep trade unions intact despite alleged attacks on trade unionism by the Conservative government.
MS1175/3	1928	Independent Order of Oddfellows Manchester Unity certificate	Certifying that Gladys Ashman was admitted a member of the Loyal Royal Naval Juvenile Lodge on the 22 <sup>nd</sup> October 1928.
MS1175/4	c. 1910	Anarchist poster	Poster of newspaper article about an anarchist bombing of a cinema in Liege, Belgium.
MS1175/5	c 1907	National Anti-Sweating League flyer	Supports campaign to secure a minimum wage. It defines sweating, outlines the extent of sweating and asks members of the public to join the League and work for the abolition of sweating
MS1175/6	1979-c2001	Political cards and ephemera.	Includes "Adoration of the Kinnock" (c1983), card showing miners picketing of Lea Hall pit, Staffordshire (1984 September) (31 items)

MS1175/7	Undated	Card to Brenda Brett.	Brenda Brett was the Secretary of Campaign for Labour Party Democracy. Signatures include Ernie Roberts and Jeremy Corbyn
MS1175/8	c1906-c1920	Postcards – mostly radical and Labour Party figures.	Includes postcards of John Burns, Labour MPs in 1906, Arthur Greenwood, Arthur Richardson, James Rowlands, John MacPherson. Other themes: hop-picking, harvesting, gutting herrings (12 items)
MS1175/9	c2004	Cards from Ken Currie.	Christmas and New Year cards from the painter Ken Currie to Ron Heisler. (3 items)
MS1175/10	c1822	Etchings.	Picture cards of Major Cartwright, H. Hunt Esq. Mr T. J. Wooler, Mr Cobbett. (4 items)
MS1175/11	1897	United Society of London's Firemen Benevolent Fund receipts.	Signed by J.B. Bramwell and J. Kinsman. Each for 2 shillings and 6 pence. (2 items)
MS1175/12	1927	Mildmay Old Comrades' concerts: programme of entertainment.	The Black and White Terriers Concert party presented by Miss Madge Penny. Programme also includes various ads for beverages and advice for members about keeping their programmes.
MS1175/13	1922	The National Union of General Workers subscription card.	Card belonging to J. Mahon.
MS1175/14	c1891	Messrs. Henry Milward & Sons flyer	Double-sided flyer advertising Milward & Sons needles. Includes an illustration of Washford Mills and an anecdote about Milward's self-threading (calyx-eyed) needles mentioned in Isabella's Bird book, Journeys in Persia.
MS1175/15	1895 April 22	Working Men's Benevolent Society- Donation Receipt	A receipt from Bethnal Green Working Men's Benevolent Society, for the sum of one pound and one shilling donated by Miss J. Morgan for aiding the funds of hospitals & dispensaries.

MS1175/16	1900 February 13	Engineers' Mutual Association- Invitation Card	An invitation to the first Engineers' Mutual Association annual supper. Held at the Cardigan Arms Hotel. Tickets are 2 shillings and 6 pence.
MS1175/17	1947 July	Working Mens Club & Institute Union Associate card	Associate card of George W... Sha... of the Ilkeston Miners WE27 ARF??? (Card no. E49981)
MS1175/18	1966 February	Notice of strike action by the National Union of Railwaymen	A flyer instructing the National Union of Railwaymen members of Eastleigh branches Nos 1, 2, 3 & 5 and Winchester branch no.1, to strike on the 14 <sup>th</sup> February 1966.
MS1175/19	1933 January 11	Unemployed Men Club in Oxford – photograph.	Black & white image portraying members of the newly formed Unemployed Men's Club at Oxford having a cup of tea. (Fox photo. Includes a caption overleaf).
