MS1210/1/1	01-01-1871 to 31-12-1871	Diary of Colonel Charles William Paulet (1832-1897)	<p>Lett's diary for 1871: "Charles W. Paulet. Wellesbourne. Janry 1<sup>st</sup>. 1871." Detailed record of his daily life: description of the weather, correspondence with family and friends, gifts received on his birthday, having his haircut, local excursions with friends, a shooting party. Holidays abroad.</p> <p>The daily calendar of notable dates at the front of the diary is marked (eg.12 August, grouse shooting begins) and annotated with payments made.</p> <p>At the back of the diary is a section with two blank pages for each</p>

			<p>month: this has been used to record purchases and payments for goods and services and also a record of currency changes in July and August, amounts received for £20 at Frankfurt, Kissingen, Lindau, Lucerne, Berne.</p> <p><i>Charles William Paulet, the son of the Rev. Charles Paulet whose father was the 13<sup>th</sup> Marquess of Winchester, married Susan Amelia Standish, daughter of William Standish. They had two sons, Charles Standish and Cecil Henry Paulet.</i></p>
