Introduction (see also p. 3, 'General Introduction')

The letters of H.S. Foxwell, officials of the University of London, members of the Goldsmiths' Company, and others, with Sir Walter S. Prideaux, Clerk of the Goldsmiths' Company, with copies of some of Prideaux's letters, 1901-16.

The papers were deposited in the University of London Library by the Goldsmiths' Company in 1970. They have been filed and listed in chronological order. This order differs slightly from the arrangement made by the Goldsmiths' Company, but each item bears its previous (Goldsmiths' Company) number in red ink, so that the original order can be followed if necessary. The Goldsmiths' file-numbers are M66 - M69.
