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PREFATORY NOTE

The subject of this catalogue of documents, MS.814, was given to the University of London Library in July 1973 by Mrs. Honoria Wormald, widow of Francis Wormald, Professor of Palaeography in the University of London from 1949-60, and Director of the Institute of Historical Research from 1960-67.

It is not known how or when Professor Wormald acquired these manuscripts, but one may hazard a guess why they had an interest for him. Their range, demonstrating English hands evolving over a period of 500 years, must have seemed suitable material to one who was, among many other things, a great teacher of palaeography.

So, it seemed particularly appropriate that Dr. Diana Greenway should have chosen to use this source in her Extra-Mural course in palaeography and diplomatic, held in the Palaeography Room of the University Library, during the session 1974-75. Together with the members of her class (whose names are listed below) she has produced a catalogue and indices that will not only be a useful guide to the material in MS.814, but will also serve as a model to all students of palaeography and diplomatic. The University Library is indebted to them all.

INTRODUCTION

MS.814 is a volume containing eighty documents, now guarded, arranged in their present order probably before 1900. No common factor has been discovered which would suggest that the documents were collected for a particular purpose. Most of the documents are property deeds and the estates mentioned are found in 30 counties in England and 3 in Wales, with one relating to Jersey, C.I. The earliest document (no.4) dates from before 1162, and the latest from 1659 (no.76). The documents are in Latin, except where otherwise stated in the catalogue. No seals survive.

The catalogue gives first the type of document (e.g. gift with warranty, bargain and sale, etc.), followed by the names of the chief parties, in a modern form where possible. The name of the place or places concerned is given in capital letters, with brief details of the property, such as the amount of land; if the bounds of a tenement are specified, the fact is noted. The name of any place which has not been identified is given in the form used in the document, with quotation marks. Where a rent and/or a consideration is mentioned, the amount is noted. The catalogue states if a document is witnessed, and also gives the place and/or date of the transaction. Dates are in new style. For undated documents conjectured dates are given, based on internal and palaeographical evidence. Endorsements are not noted unless they give relevant additional information (such as a disclaimer by a wife, no.68).

An index is provided of persons and places mentioned in the catalogue. Where possible, persons have been entered under family names, with cross-references from places. The main entries for persons with patronyms are given under first names (e.g. William son of Hugh, entered under William). There is a subsidiary index of places under counties (boundaries existing before local government reorganisation in 1974), which is designed to be used in conjunction with the main index.
