ACI Academic Council: Introductory Note

The Academic Council was created by the Statutes of 13 February 1900 to provide advice on the 'Internal' side of the University's activities. (The External work was carried out by the Council for External Students while the Board to Promote the Extension of University Teaching dealt with 'extension' or Extra-Mural activities.)

The Academic Council was composed of 16 Senators representing Faculties (2 each), plus the Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor and Chairman of Convocation, together with other Senators sufficient to make the number up to 20. The Academic Council had an advisory role only on the following matters:

- '(i) The assignment of funds for the erection or extension of buildings or for the provision of apparatus or equipment in the University or in the Schools of the University;
 - (ii) The admission in whole or in part of duly qualified institutions as Schools of the University;
 - (iii) The appointment of Professors Assistant Professors Readers or Lecturers of the University;
 - (iv) The allocation of funds either for the endowment or remuneration of Appointed Teachers or in connection with Schools of the University;
 - (v) The determination of the duties of Appointed Teachers of the University;
- (vi) The recognition of members of the teaching staffs of public educational institutions within the appointed radius as Teachers of the University;
- (vii) The regulation of the courses of study for Internal Students of the University and the provision of opportunities for and aids to research;
- (viii) The appointment of Examiners for Internal Students;
- (ix) The superintendence regulation and conduct of the examinations for Internal Students;
- (x) The equalisation as far as possible of the standards of knowledge and attainments prescribed for the degrees conferred upon Internal and External Students respectively;
- (xi) Any matter relating to the Internal Students upon which either the Faculties or the Boards of Studies to be appointed as hereinafter provided shall have reported;
- (xii) The extent to which work done under the superintendence of the Board to be appointed as hereinafter provided to promote the Extension of University Teaching ought to be recognised as an equivalent for parts of the prescribed course of study as hereinafter provided.
- (xiii) Generally upon any matter relating to the Internal Students. (1)

Academic Council: Introductory Note (contd.) ACl

This arrangement was found to be unsatisfactory in that the Academic Council had no executive power and its recommendations were frequently overriden by the Senate. (2) Consequently the Hilton-Young reforms, embodied in the Statutes of 23 July 1928 (3) allocated to the Academic Council executive functions in the following areas previously exercised by the Senate:

- The constitution and personnel of Faculties, Boards of Studies and the regulation and co-ordination of their work:
 - (ii) The admission or retention of public educational institutions as Schools;
- (iii) The establishment or abolition of posts of Professors, Readers and Lecturers of the University and the duties, tenure, remuneration and conditions of service, retirement and superannuation which shall apply to persons appointed to such posts;
- (iv) The reocognition of teachers;
- The establishment of degrees, diplomas and certificates of proficiency for Internal Students;
- (vi) The regulation of courses of study for Internal Students;
- (vii) The recognition of courses of study for Associate Students;
- (viii)The regulation, conduct and superintendence of examinations for Internal Students, and the appointment of Examiners for such examinations;
- (ix) The conditions under which the Higher School Examination of the University may be accepted in whole or in part, as . equivalent of the Intermediate Examination for Internal Students;
- (x)Such other matters as the Senate may prescribe. (4)

It will be noted that the Academic Council lost its role in giving advice on the assignment of funds for building and equipment. In 1928 this role was taken over, in much enhanced form, by the Court. its influence over teaching and examination was strengthened by the power to appoint and regulate the work of Boards of Studies and Faculty The collective expertise of the Academic Council was broadened by enlarging its composition to comprise 2 ex officio members (the Vice-Chancellor and the Principal), 17 Senators representing the Faculties, and 9 other Senators appointed with regard 'to subjects of study and academic interests not otherwise represented on the Council, and the Senate shall take into consideration any representations made to them by any Board of Faculty or of Studies or by any of the Special Advisory Boards' (5)

With the exception of an amendment of 1951 on account of the creation of G.C.E. examinations, the Statutes concerning the Academic Council remained unchanged until the 'Saunders reforms' of 1966.(6) Under these changes the Faculty Boards were abolished (they were replaced by Academic Advisory Boards), the membership of the Boards

of Studies was extended to include all tenured Teachers in Schools, and the programme of School-sponsored degrees was extended.

The Statutes of 17 December 1980 have brought about major changes. The composition of the Academic Council has been substantially enlarged; thus:

"The Academic Council shall consist of the Vice-Chancellor, the Principal, the forty members of the Senate elected by the Teachers, the ten members of the Senate to be co-opted from the Recognised Teachers, and other persons exceeding nine in number annually appointed to the Senate. The Senate shall, in appointing these other persons, have regard, among other things, to subjects not otherwise represented on the Council.' (7)

Furthermore the Statutes provide that from session 1984/85 the Council for External Students be retitled 'the Committee for External Students' of the Academic Council, while the Council for Extra-Mural Studies will become the 'Committee for Extra-Mural Studies' and the University Entrance Requirements Committee will become a committee directly constituted by the Senate. These new committees will report to the Academic Council.

AC 4 Joint Standing Committee of the Academic and Collegiate Councils: Introductory Note.

The Joint Standing Committee of the Academic and Collegiate Councils was established in May 1966 on the recommendation of the Robbins Report Steering Committee "for the general surveillance of matters in which the interests of both Councils are involved."(1) Initially, it was regarded as an experiment in providing the necessary liaison between the two Councils and was, therefore, constituted on an interim basis.

It was emphasised, however, that although the creation of the Interim Joint Standing Committee would ensure the necessary close consultation between the Academic and Collegiate Councils, it would not eliminate the need for ad hoc joint committees to deal with specific problems. Indeed, one of the functions of the newly established Committee was to foresee and identify such needs.

The Committee first met on 16 November 1966 and in subsequent years it became involved not only in general planning of academic policy but also in the preparation of a number of major constitutional matters. In 1975, the Committee was given the task of preparing the draft University of London Act and, in 1979, when the Statutes Revision Committee was discharged by the Senate as part of the general policy of reducing the number of committees, the Interim Joint Standing Committee was made responsible for drafting the second phase of the proposed new Statutes of the University. Since then, the Committee has been concerned almost entirely with matters relating to the constitution of the University.

In 1981, in view of the additional duties allocated to the Committee, it was considered appropriate for the word "interim" to be deleted from its title and it was renamed the Joint Standing Committee of the Academic and Collegiate Councils. (2)

At its meeting of 14 July 1982 the Senate approved the new terms of reference for the Committee:

- "(i) to consider matters in which the interests of both the Academic and the Collegiate Councils are involved which do not fall under the purview of any other joint committee of the two Councils;
- (ii) to advise the Academic and the Collegiate Councils on matters relating to the constitution of the University including the regulations for elections to the Senate and the Standing Orders of the Senate;
- (iii) to advise the Academic and Collegiate Councils on matters concerning the organisation and administration of schools;

AC5 Faculties: Introductory Note

It could be said that the precursors of the Faculties provided by the Statutes of 13 February 1900 can be found as early as 1837 when there were appointed separate committees for the Faculty of Laws (1) and the Faculty of Medicine.(2) However, until 1900 the University of London was an examining body only, thus the faculty committees dealt with the examination of particular subject areas rather than represented the teachers of those subjects as was the case later. Arguably the true origins of the present day Faculties lie in the campaign for a teaching University, which saw fruition in the University of London Act 1898. The Act transformed the University into an institution where the teachers played a part in its governance.

The Statutes of 1900 ordained that each Faculty comprise the Appointed Teachers of the University plus 'such other Teachers of the University as may from time to time be admitted to a Faculty by the Senate' (3) The most important function of the Faculties was to elect 16 Senators (2 for each Faculty). In addition Statute 68 provided that:

'... the members shall consider and report upon any matter referred to them by the Senate and may also consider and report upon any matter relating to courses of study provision for teaching or research examinations or the granting of degrees or certificates of proficiency in the subjects comprised within that Faculty.' (4)

The Faculties also had an important role in recommending to the Senate the personnel of Boards of Studies.

In practice the Faculties tended to be too large to be entirely effective (except in their role as electoral colleges). Consequently the larger Faculties such as Arts and Science Faculty Boards were created from 1923 onwards to do much of the Faculties' advisory work (q.v.) With the abolition of Faculty Boards in 1968 the Faculties ceased to function except to elect the Dean of each Faculty, although according to Statute they retained an advisory role. (5)

AC6 Faculty Boards: Introductory Note

Although not mentioned in the Statutes until 1928, Faculty Boards existed much earlier. The first Faculty Board was created by the Faculty of Arts which, in seeking approval from the Senate explained:

'These Statutes [106 and 68] give the Faculty the right to be informed and to express an opinion upon almost every matter that concerns it. But this right is very difficult to exercise without frequent, regular and representative meetings of the Faculty, which are not easily secured in the case of so large and varied a body. is suggested that this difficulty might be overcome by the appointment of a representative committee which could meet frequently as required. Such a committee would, of course, have no official status or rights under the present Statutes; but it is suggested that a letter sent by the Dean after consulting such a committee would carry some weight in any matter affecting the interests of the Faculty. A meeting of the Faculty would, of course, be necessary in all cases where an official expression of its opinion was required, and such a meeting should be held at least once in each term.' (1) The Faculties of Science and Medicine appear to have followed soon after although no minutes of any Faculty Board survive until 1923. (2) Faculty Boards included members representing the External part of the University who were not members of Faculties, which widened the Boards' base beyond the Faculties themselves.

The Statues of 1928 largely formalised this development. The duties of the Faculty Boards were:

'to advise the Academic Council and the Council for External Students, and to exercise any delegated powers in respect of:

- (i) The scope and correlation of courses of study in the subjects within the purview of the Faculty;
- (ii) The provision for teaching or research in each such subject;
- (iii) The correlation of examinations in such subjects and the conditions on which degrees, diplomas and certificates of proficiency shall be granted;
- (iv) The personnel of Boards of Studies for such subjects;
- (v) Any other matters which may be referred to it. (4) Their most important additional role was to collect and consolidate the advice of the Boards of Studies.

During the 1960s the Faculty Boards became increasingly criticised by teachers of the University. The Robbins Report Steering Committee appointed to investigate the goverance of the University felt that the range of subjects covered by each Faculty Board was too wide to be compatible with a common pattern of degree structure and entrance requirements. Moreover, as the Committee remarked in its report 'The powers of veto and delay which Faculty Boards possess.....have been the subject of considerable criticism within the University'.(5) Consequently the Faculty Boards were abolished in 1968 and replaced by the much weaker Academic Advisory Boards (q.v.)

The Academic Advisory Boards were created in 1968(1) to suceed the Faculty Boards (q.v.), but, in accordance with the recommendations of the Robbins Report Steering Committee, (2) they were much less powerful. Their terms of reference are 'to provide for consultation among Boards of Studies and Schools on matters of common academic interest and for the co-ordination of their work in such matters.'(3) The personnel of the Boards comprise the following:

- '(i) That each Board should include the Deans of Faculties appropriate to the fields of study with which the Board is concerned.
 - (ii) That each Board should include the Chairman or his deputy of each Board of Studies in the fields of study which lie within the area of interest of the Board.
- (iii) That each Board should include representatives of the Schools of the University offering courses which lie within the area of interest of the Board.
- (iv) That each Board should, where appropriate, include at least one representative of the Council for External Students.'(4)

In practice many of these Boards never meet and exist in name only.

Founding and Constitution

The first Boards of Studies were created on the recommendation of the Special Committee on the Revision of Curricula and Syllabuses, which reported as follows to the Senate on 15 July 1896:

"That it is advisable to commit the revision of the syllabuses in the different faculties to bodies specially appointed for the purpose, to be designated Boards of Studies, and to consist of members of the senate conversant with the subjects of the respective syllabuses, of the present examiners o those subjects, and not less than three other persons having a special knowledge of the same subjects, being neither members of the senate nor present examiners." (1) The Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor were ex officio members.

Five boards were appointed: Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Modern Languages and Literatures (2), and Mental and Moral Science (3). They were followed later in the year by Boards in Classics and Political Economy (4), and finally History in November. The Statutes of 13 February 1900 increased the number of Boards and incorporated them into the constitution.

In this period the members were appointed by the senate from members of the faculty teaching or examining in any of the subjects of the Board or "such other persons...provided always that the number of such other persons shall in no case exceed one-fourth of the total number of the members of the Board." (5) Teachers appointed as Officers of the University were included by the Statute which required that, "In appointing members of the said Boards the Senate shall take care that Teachers of the University not belonging to any School of the University shall be adequately represented in each Board."(6)

The Boards of Studies rapidly became established and were soon regarded as a success in furthering the corporate life of the University by allowing teachers to control the curriculum and meet together to build schools in their subjects which transcended the limits of their individual institutions. (7) they were also consulted by the Council for External Students and the Academic Council on the appointment of examiners.

The situation remained unchanged until the constitutional changes of 1928 placed the Boards of Studies under the general supervision of the Academic Council with respect of their constitution, personnel. Regulation and co-ordination of their work. (8) Moreover the Boards were expanded to include all appointed teachers engaging in teaching the subject with which the Board dealt as well as recognised teachers and other expert in the subject of the Board. It was not permitted that the recognised teachers exceeded the number of appointed teachers who were members of the Board. (9) These reforms removed the presence of numerous members who were not university teachers in the accepted sense while it increased the participation of the teaching staff. (10)

Powers and Duties

In addition to changing the constitution of the Boards of Studies the reorganisation of 1928 gave to each Board "such executive functions as may be delegated to it." (11) The executive functions were to become a major part of the duties of the Board, though inevitably they were disparate in nature. (12) In broad terms they comprised the development of courses, syllabuses, and the supervision of postgraduate study.

This scheme remained essentially the same until the reorganisations which came in the wake of the Robbins Report (13). The Robbins Report Steering Committee reconsidered the role of the Boards of Studies in the light of over thirty years of change. Inter alia it recommended that the duties of the Boards of Studies should be as follows:

- "a) To consider and initiate proposals for securing the most advantageous use of recourses of the university and its schools in the field of study with which the Board is concerned.
- b) To receive all proposals submitted by schools for courses of study which fall within the purview of the board of studies and, if it so desires, to offer advice to schools upon such proposals.
- c) Where the planning of courses of study is the responsibility of the Board of Studies to advise the Academic Council on the approval of syllabuses and regulations concerning the courses of study, examinations, and the award of the degree, diploma or certificate.
- d) To assist schools both generally and in particular cases with advice on qualifications other than degrees of the University which may be offered as evidence of suitable preparation for undertaking a course of study for a higher degree.
- e) To advise the Academic Council on the appointment of persons to serve as members of Boards of Advisors for the appointment of professors and readers.
- f) To advise the Academic Council on the recognition of teachers other than those in Schools of the University or Senate Institutes upon the appointment of examiners when requested to do so.
- g) To advise the Academic Council and the Council for External Students upon the appointment of examiners when requested to do so.
- h) To advise the Academic Council or any Committee of the Council on any other matters within the competence of the Board of Studies.
- i) To exercise such executive functions as may be delegated to it by the Academic Council.
- j) To advise the Senate, its Standing Committees and any other committee appointed by the Senate on any matter referred to it by any of these bodies.
- k) To advise any school when requested on any matter within the competence of the Board." (14)

A board of studies or its standing committee could also be empowered by the Senate to act as an Academic Advisory Board. When meeting for this purpose

its membership included persons nominated by the Council for External Students.

Constitution post 1968

The Robins Report Steering Committee recommended a change in the constitution and organisation of the Boards:

"Since most Boards will be too large for effective consideration and despatch of business it will usually be necessary to work through committees... In such cases meetings of the full Board should still be held at regular intervals, for the consideration of developments relevant to the Board's field of study, the organisation of its teaching within the University, facilities for research and any other matters of common interest." (15)

The Statutes were amended to accommodate the substance of these recommendations on 12 July 1968. The composition of the Boards was further expanded to include "Every Teacher of the University other than an Teacher on probation." (16) Each Board, at its discretion could appoint a General Committee and, unless Senate determined otherwise, a Standing Committee. (17) As part of the executive changes of 1968 a number of Boards of Studies were disbanded and re-constituted under new titles — sometimes with the effect of incorporating new combinations of subjects. Several Special Advisory Boards were promoted to Boards of Studies.

Many have not adopted the committee structure provided by the Statutes, although History, for example, has. In some cases the work of the Boards has much increased because the work load formerly carried by the Academic Council and the Faculty Boards (q.v.) has been transferred to Board of Studies level. In other cases, with the growth of school-sponsored degrees, much work relating to syllabuses has been transferred to the School's own boards.

The first phase of the new Statutes which came into effect on 17 December 1980 confirmed the existing composition of Boards of Studies. One section that was changed, however, was Statute 100 relating to the appointment by each Board of a general committee. Since the function of these committees and the meaning of the term general committee itself were considered to be unclear, it was decided to delete the term altogether and the Statute now reads:

"It shall be the duty of each Board of Studies and Academic Advisory Board to advise the Academic Council and to exercise such powers as the Senate or Academic Council may delegate to it in respect of securing effective consideration of the provision for teaching, research, and examinations for degrees, diplomas and certificates of the University in the field or fields of study which fall within its purview." (18)

BOARD OF STUDIES

Since 1968 the role of the Boards of Studies continued to develop despite great disparity between the administration of the different Boards. In 1988 the chairman of the Academic Council, recognising how the structure of the university had changed commenced a review as to whether it was still appropriate to have any Boards of Studies in individual subjects due to the growth in interdisciplinary study. In December 1989 and May 1990, following the Academic Council's submission to the Strategic Issues Group, it was recognised that there was a need to make changes to the role and operation of the federal university. As a result, from this time, the process of disbanding the Boards of Studies began. As recommended by the Strategic Issues Group, Federal Faculty Boards (also known as Subject Area Boards) would replace Boards of Studies from 1 September 1994 under the terms of the statute introduced on that date.(19)

Records of the Boards of Studies

Records of the Boards of Studies vary in content according to the administrative structure adopted by the individual board. They contain minutes, Agendas and Related Papers of the Boards of Studies and their committees including general committees (to 1980), Standing Committees, Subject Sub Committees and Higher Degree Sub Committees. Several Boards also have minutes agendas and related papers of Boards of Examiners and University of London Intercollegiate Research Services (ULIRS) although it is not clear how these boards fitted in administratively with the boards of studies. Correspondence and secretary's papers, which comprised minutes and related correspondence, cover all aspects of the Boards' work. Academic correspondence, including correspondence with the academic department, dealt with course proposals, structure, syllabus planning and enquiries concerning course entry requirements. Correspondence files also include administration of the boards constitution and membership. Examiners correspondence and related material concerned appointments of internal and external examiners.
