One method used to communicate with the dead (called "the unseen" by Rhys-Davids) was to allow them to use the participants hand to write, this is referred to as "automatic writing". Rhys-Davids also writes as if being dictated to. Notes and automatic writing added later throughout c.1930-40. notes recording questions and answers with the unseen, predominantly Rhys-Davids' son.
